Margaret & Barry Mizen FORGIVENESS, PEACE & HOPE

Sixteen-year-old Jimmy Mizen was murdered in May 2008 when he and his older brother Harry went into a bakery near their home in Lee, south east London. While inside, Jake Fahri – who had been cautioned by police several years earlier for harassing Harry Mizen – brushed past the brothers. A scuffle followed which resulted in Fahri hurling a glass dish at Jimmy and fatally wounding him. Jimmy's parents, Barry and Margaret Mizen, hit national headlines when immediately after the attack they spoke of compassion rather than revenge.



The Jimmy Mizen Foundation was set up as a positive way of remembering Jimmy and works within the community.

"Following the murder of our son Jimmy in May 2008, we as a family have been determined of two outcomes. We will not be beaten by his death and that something good will come from it."
